SWEET POTATOE CASSEROLE By Ardis

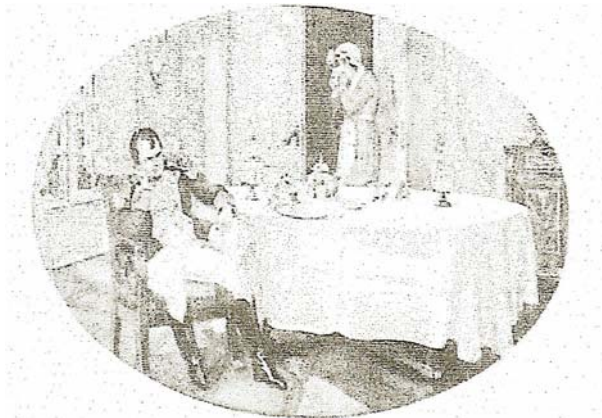
3 C. fresh sweet potatoes cooked
1 C sugar
½ C. milk
½ stick butter
2 eggs
Dash of salt
1 tsp. vanilla

TOPPING

1 C. brown sugar
1/4 plain flour
½ stick butter (softened)
1/4 to 1 C. chopped
pecans

Cook and peel sweet potatoes and put into mixer bowl. Add sugar, eggs, milk, salt, vanilla and butter. Beat with mixer until smooth. Put mixture into greased 2 quart casserole. Cover with topping and bake uncovered at 350 for 30 minutes.

Topping prep: Mix sugar, flour and butter, add pecans and spread over casserole. This freezes well! Use 1/2 recipe for 9x13 pan. Enjoy!!!!
